<u>Definition:</u> A student on this track will receive a high school diploma. Students must complete the following course requirements with a grade "D" or higher grade. Admission to Community College is open to anyone who is at least 18 years old, or has a high school diploma or the equivalent ( <i>STCHS does not offer Certificates of Completion or GED</i> ). At a Community College, one can obtain a AS, AA, Certification, or Transfer to a four-year College or Competitive College. <u>Cost</u> : Full time student annual cost approximately \$1,300 a year for tuition at Community Colleges in California.	Definition: A four-year college where one can obtain their Bachelor's degree (BA: Bachelor of Arts or BS: Bachelor in Science). Master's and PHD programs are also available.  Application Requirements:  SAT or ACT test (scores vary by school)  "C" or better in core classes GPA must be above a 2.0  Cost: Full time student annual cost approximately \$8,000 a year for tuition at California State University schools.	Definition: A four-year competitive college where one can obtain their Bachelor's degree (BA: Bachelor of Arts or BS: Bachelor in Science). Master's and PHD programs are also available.  Application Requirements:  SAT or ACT test (scores vary by school)  "C" or better in core classes  GPA must be above a 3.0  Cost: Full time student annual cost approximately \$13,000 a year for tuition at University of California schools.
